

**ALBERTA PROVINCIAL HIGH POINT AWARDS PROGRAM
SPONSORED BY THE WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY OF ALBERTA**

AWARDS FROM WELSH SHOW PLACINGS

Eligibility Requirements

1. Canadian shows must be approved and conform to Show Rules of the WPCSC and must offer a minimum of four classes specific to Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs in either Halter, Performance or both. Barn shows/in-house schooling shows are not eligible. Shows must be advertised to the public no less than 30 days before the closing of entries.
2. Only Canadian Residents and Welsh Ponies & Cobs and Half-Welsh registered with the WPCSC, WPCSA or WPCS are eligible for points. Points submitted for Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs under the age of one year will only be accepted if the animal is submitted to the WPCSC by November 15th of the current show year.
3. Owner/lessee of record must be a current member of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta prior to points being earned and each pony must show at one Alberta qualifying show in order for their points to be counted.
4. First six (6) placings in each class will count for points.
5. In classes where multiple animals count as one entry (Pairs, Tandems, Unicorns, four-in-hand, six-in-hand), the animals making up the entry must remain the same throughout the point year. Each animal will receive full points.
6. Performance Awards can be obtained in open classes at Canadian shows as long as the show offers a minimum of four classes specific to Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs.
 - English Pleasure, Western Pleasure and Pleasure Driving points can be earned in Junior, Senior, Maiden, Novice, Green and Welsh Pleasure classes.
 - Hunter Under Saddle points can be earned in Hunter Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle classes.
 - Hunter Hack, Walk Poles or Trot Pony Hunter classes do not count towards Hunter Over Fences points.
 - Purebred Welsh and Half Welsh points can be earned in either a Purebred Welsh/Half Welsh class or class for Registered Pony Breeds but cannot earn points from both classes at the same show.
7. If Performance or Halter Classes have been combined, each pony will gain points towards their respective divisions. Example: A combined 3 & Over Stallions/Geldings class – points earned by a Stallion will go towards their 3 & Over Stallion Year-End Award and points earned by a Gelding will go towards their Gelding Section Award.
8. Entrants must have a minimum of three points throughout the show year to be eligible for any awards.

Point Scoring

For classes with 4 or more entries competing:

First = 7 points
Second = 5 points
Third = 4 points
Fourth = 3 point
Fifth = 2 points
Sixth = 1 point

For classes with 3 entries competing:

First = 3 points
Second = 2 point
Third = 1 point

For classes with 2 entries competing:

First = 2 points
Second = 1 point

For classes with 1 entry competing:

First = 1 point

AVAILABLE HALTER AWARDS

Separate breeding awards for Section A; Section B; Section C/D will be offered for the following:

- 2 & under filly
- 2 & under colt
- 3 & over mare
- 3 & over stallion
- 2 & under geldings
- 3 & over geldings

The following halter award will also be offered:

- Half-Welsh 2& Under – any age
- Half-Welsh 3 & Over – any age

AVAILABLE PERFORMANCE AWARDS*

Section A, B, C, D and Half-Welsh are combined for all Performance Awards

- Pleasure Driving – Senior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D, half-Welsh)

- English Pleasure - Junior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Hunter Under Saddle - Senior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Hunter Under Saddle - Junior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Hunter Over Fences - Senior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Hunter Over Fences- Junior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Western Pleasure - Senior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)
- Western Pleasure - Junior Exhibitor (Award open to A/B/C/D/Half-Welsh)

SPECIAL AWARDS

Junior Sportsmanship Award

- open to juniors riding all breeds of ponies, not just Welsh Ponies or Cobs. Points do not count towards this award, only sportsmanship and manners.

Super Welsh Pony Award, Super Welsh Cob Award & Super Half Welsh Award

- for points to count, the Welsh Pony or Cob must compete in halter and in at least two performance divisions.
