High Point Program FAQ's

THE SHOW I JUST ATTENDED ONLY HAD TWO WELSH HALTER CLASSES. CAN I SUBMIT MY HALTER POINTS FOR THE AWARDS PROGRAM?

No. In order for Halter points to count, points must be earned at a show offering a minimum of four Welsh classes specific to Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs in either Halter, Performance or both.

MY DAUGHTER SHOWED OUR WELSH PONY IN ENGLISH PLEASURE AT A WELSH SHOW THIS PAST WEEKEND. CAN I SUBMIT HER SHOW RESULTS FOR THE AWARDS PROGRAM?

Yes, if she or the entire family purchased a current Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta Membership and the membership was processed before the start of the show. If a membership was not purchased until after the completion of the show, only future show results will count.

I RECENTLY ATTENDED A SHOW WITH MY PONY ON THE WEEKEND. MY PONY IS CO-OWNED WITH ANOTHER PERSON BUT I AM THE ONLY ONE WITH A CURRENT WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY OF ALBERTA MEMBERSHIP. THE CO-OWNER HAS NOT RENEWED THEIR MEMBERSHIP FOR THIS YEAR. CAN I STILL SUBMIT MY PONY'S POINTS?

No. If a pony is co-owned, all owners involved must at least have current individual or family Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta memberships before the start of the show.

MY PONY WON A TOTAL OF 2 POINTS IN HUNTER FOR THE YEAR AND HAD THE MOST POINTS IN SENIOR HUNTER FOR THE YEAR. WHY DIDN'T I WIN AN AWARD FOR SENIOR HUNTER?

Entrants must have a minimum of three (3) points throughout the show year to be eligible for any awards.

MY PONY WON HIS SECTION A STALLION CLASS AGAINST TWO OTHER STALLIONS AND WAS THEN NAMED SECTION A CHAMPION STALLION. HOW COME HIS 3 & OVER STALLION CLASS COUNTED FOR POINTS BUT HIS CHAMPION STALLION CLASS POINTS DID NOT COUNT?

For the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta program, only the halter class counts for points. Championship points are not counted for the awards program.

MY PONY DID NOT PLACE IN HER SECTION B HALTER CLASS, BUT DID PLACE IN HER SPORT PONY CLASS AT THE SHOW. WHY DID SHE NOT EARN ANY HALTER POINTS FOR THE SHOW?

The Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta Year-End Awards are Welsh Awards only. Sport Pony classes are judged on a different criteria than a Welsh halter class. Therefore, only Welsh halter classes count for points.

MY PONY HAS EARNED A BUNCH OF POINTS FOR NATIONAL AND REGIONAL AWARDS THIS YEAR, BUT HIS POINTS SEEM TO HAVE BEEN TABULATED DIFFERENTLY FOR ALBERTA PROVINCIAL AWARDS. WHY DIDN'T HE EARN THE SAME POINTS IN BOTH PROGRAMS?

The National and Regional points and Year-End Awards are part of the WPCSC National High Point Program. Any Province that offers separate Provincial Awards are done so by private clubs or Provincial Associations and is not related to the National Point Program. Therefore, the rules for Provincial Awards may be very different than for the WPCSC National High Point Program.

WHY ARE THE RESULTS FOR ALL OF THE ALBERTA WELSH SHOWS NOT POSTED ON THE WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY OF ALBERTA WEBSITE?

The website is maintained only for items that relate directly to the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta activities and the All Breed Pony Show, which is hosted by the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta.
