

Alberta Provincial High Point Awards Program

SPONSORED BY THE WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY OF ALBERTA

- For points to be accumulated and recorded by the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta for Year-End High Point awards, you must be a Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta member before points will be accumulated.
- Take a copy with you to **EVERY** show and event your animal participates in during the show year which starts January 1st and ends November 30th
- After your animal has finished competing at a particular show or event, you are to present a copy of this form to the show official in charge of awards, if uncertain ask the Show Secretary. **Have him /her verify and sign** this form.
- Then, the registered animals owner is to return, by Postal Mail or Fax, a copy of each and every filled out form to the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta at the address **or** Fax number listed below. They **MUST** be in our office by or before November 30th of the nominated show year. Failure to follow these instructions will terminate possible awards for that show season / year.
- Please read the Alberta Provincial High Point Awards Program Rules & Regulations (below) and make sure all requirements have been met before your show season starts. Failure to meet the rules & regulation requirements may terminate possible points and/or awards for that show season / year.
- Feel free to make copies of this form as needed – you may use your printer or photocopier.

Rules & Regulations

1. Canadian or American shows must conform to Show Rules of the WPCSC and/or WPCSA and must offer a minimum of four classes specific to Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs in either Halter, Performance or both.
2. Only **Alberta Residents** and Welsh Ponies & Cobs and Half-Welsh registered with the WPCSC, WPCSA or WPCS are eligible for points. Exception for Welsh & Half-Welsh weanlings who have not received their registration papers yet. All ponies one year of age or older, must have registration papers in order to be eligible for points.
3. Owner/lessee of record must be a current member of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Alberta prior to points being earned.
4. First six (6) placings in each class will count for points.
5. In classes where multiple animals count as one entry (Pairs, Tandems, Unicorns, four-in-hand, six-in-hand), the animals making up the entry must remain the same throughout the point year. Each animal will receive full points.
6. Performance Awards can be obtained in open classes at a Canadian or American show as long as the show offers a minimum of four classes specific to Welsh Ponies and/or Cobs.
 - English Pleasure and Western Pleasure points can be earned in Junior, Senior, Maiden, Green and Welsh Pleasure classes.
 - Hunter Under Saddle points can be earned in Hunter Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle classes.
 - Hunter Hack, Walk Poles or Trot Pony Hunter classes do not count towards Hunter Over Fences points.
 - Half-Welsh points can be earned in either a Half-Welsh class or class for Registered Pony Breeds other than Purebred Welsh but cannot earn points from both classes at the same show.
7. If Performance or Halter Classes have been combined, each pony will gain points towards their respective divisions. Example: A combined 3 & Over Stallions/Geldings class – points earned by a Stallion will go towards their 3 & Over Stallion Year-End Award and points earned by a Gelding will go towards their Gelding Section Award.
